TICKET TERMS & CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By purchasing tickets to gain entry to the 2024 Track Nations Cup: Adelaide (Event) you agree to the following conditions of entry:

1. The right of admission is reserved. In particular, AusCycling reserves the right to refuse entry to Patrons or Users who
 - a. are in breach of these Conditions of Entry;
 - b. are not entitled to attend the event, activity or match;
 - c. are the subject of a ban by AusCycling or AusCycling; or
 - d. are exhibiting behaviour that is considered unacceptable by AusCycling's absolute discretion.
2. AusCycling reserves the right to remove Patrons or Users who:
 - a. refuse to comply with reasonable requests from AusCycling;
 - b. refuse to comply with these Conditions of Entry; or
 - c. are exhibiting behaviour that is deemed unacceptable by AusCycling, in its absolute discretion.
1. AusCycling reserves the right to impose a ban on a Patron or User in instances where their actions are deemed by AusCycling or SA Office of Sport to be sufficiently serious to compromise someone's safety or amount to a serious breach of the Conditions of Entry.
2. For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all persons, AusCycling (AC) advise that persons who gain unauthorised access to the Event and/or any of the event specific areas may be liable for prosecution.
3. Entry to the Event is at your own risk, including risk to your person and your property, and you agree that AC will not be liable to you for any injury, death, loss or damage which you sustain in connection with your attendance at the Event, nor for any matter outside of AC's reasonable control such as but not limited to any blackout, power failure or failure or unavailability of any service.
4. You agree to indemnify AC against any loss or liability, cost, expense or damage arising from or in relation to your entry to the Event either in person, by vehicle or otherwise.
5. AC reserves the right to cancel, withdraw, postpone or re-schedule any displays, competitions, or participants in the Event. AC does not represent that there will be space for you to observe any displays or events within the premise.
6. You may use personal cameras and video cameras for private use only. Professional photography and recording equipment are not permitted.
7. You consent to being photographed, filmed, and recorded as a member of the Event audience. Unless otherwise agreed with AC, you consent to AC and third parties using images and recordings of you for broadcast, publication and licensing without compensation or acknowledgement.

8. AC reserves the right to inspect and/or search bags brought into or out of the Event and to search all persons, their clothing and other items of such persons.
9. AC may, at their sole discretion, refuse entry to or remove any person from the Event without entitlement to a refund, including any person who causes a nuisance or disturbance or fails to comply with these Conditions of Entry or the reasonable requests made by AC and/or affiliating companies.
10. Vehicles and other transportation devices including but not limited to skateboards, scooters, roller blades and roller skates (except if required for a disability or approved by AC); alcohol, animals (except for guide animals required for a disability or approved by AC); dangerous, controlled or illegal substances; and any items which may cause a nuisance or danger are prohibited from the Event and Venue and are subject to immediate confiscation by AC.
11. Persons entering the Event must adhere to the relevant Occupational Health & Safety legislation.
12. Smoking is not permitted within the Event or Venue.
13. Any ticket purchased to enable entry into the Event cannot be exchanged or returned after purchase.
14. If you bring children to the Event you are responsible for their care and conduct. All children attending the Event must be under the supervision of an adult guardian at all times. You are responsible for any acts or omissions committed by children whom you have brought to the Event. For avoidance of doubt a child is a person under the age of 15 years.
15. All accidents or emergencies are to be immediately reported to AC and/or affiliated companies.
16. You must obey all signs, notices and directions given by AC and affiliated companies whilst at the Event.
17. Unless authorised by AC in writing, you must not conduct any commercial, political, soliciting, promotional, performance, surveying, protest or demonstration activity at the venue, nor collect contributions or distribute any material. No unauthorised advertising material or flyers may be distributed either inside the Event, at the entrance to the Event or anywhere within the Event grounds.
18. Nothing in these Conditions of Entry is intended to exclude, restrict or modify rights which you may have under consumer protection legislation which may not be excluded, restricted or modified by agreement.
19. Any part of these Conditions of Entry which is unenforceable may be severed to the extent necessary to make these Conditions of Entry enforceable.
20. Patrons or Users must not engage in any conduct, act towards or speak to any player, participant, umpire or other official or other person in a manner (whether through the use of language, gestures or otherwise) which is likely to offend, insult, humiliate, intimidate, threaten, disparage or vilify that other person on the basis of a personal attribute of that other



person, including, but not limited to, that other person's sex, gender, age, race, religion, culture, political belief or activity, sexual orientation, disability or impairment, gender identity, descent or national or ethnic origin. If Patrons fail to comply with this condition, they may be refused admission to, or evicted from, the venue by any Authorised Person, and they must deliver up any and all tickets that they have in their possession at the request of an Authorised Person. In addition, Patrons acknowledge and accept that a failure to comply with this condition of entry may result in the imposition of other sanctions (such as being issued with an official banning notice preventing the Patron from attending the venue in the future).

21. Stadiums Queensland is collecting your personal information on CCTV in and around the event precinct for the purpose of venue security and public safety. Footage may be provided to the Queensland Police Service. All personal information is handled in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2009.
22. Patrons, bags and other items may be subject to inspection and Patrons may be searched on entry. Patrons who refuse inspections or searches may be denied entry to the Venue;
23. Unauthorised persons are prohibited from entering the Velodrome areas (track or infield) and any other area not accessible by the public;
24. Pass-outs may be issued at the discretion of AusCycling management;
25. Patrons are not permitted to transmit, broadcast, sell, license or otherwise publish, disseminate or reproduce any recordings (including, without limitation, photographic, video or sound recordings) of the event or match without the prior written approval of AusCycling management. Such recordings may be confiscated or erased. Any recordings or recording devices which are confiscated will become the property of the Venue;
26. Patrons acknowledge that the Venue, UCI or the Hirer may use a Patron's image or likeness as part of any recording of the event or match;
27. Patrons assume all risk of any damage or loss (including property damage, personal injury, economic and consequential loss) however it arises at the Venue. Patrons bring personal effects onto the premises at their own risk. Neither the Venue nor the Hirer will be responsible for any damage to or loss or theft of a customer's personal property;

PROHIBITED ITEMS/ RESTRICTED ITEMS

Items which, in the opinion of AusCycling management, have the potential to cause injury, nuisance or inconvenience to any other person will not be permitted into the Venue.

X Prohibited items include:

- Controlled, dangerous or illegal substances;
- Glass, cans including aerosols or metal containers of any style;
- Alcoholic beverages;
- Flares, fireworks, weapons, explosives, smoke bombs or other incendiary devices;
- Laser pens / pointers;
- Loud hailers;
- Chairs
- Drones;
- Guns, knives or other dangerous weapons;
- Professional standard cameras with detachable lenses over 300mm, video and/or audio recorders, commercial digital equipment, camera tripods and / or monopods;
- Confetti and shredded paper;
- Scooters, roller-skates, skateboards, push bikes, Segways or other unauthorised means of transportation;

- Animals (with the exception of certified service animals);
- Clothing, personal items, signs or flags displaying commercial, political, religious or offensive signage or logos (unless approved in writing prior to the event by the hirer);
- Deliveries from external caterers;
- alcohol;
- Hard eskies larger than 40cm x 40cm x 40cm;
- Bags and items larger than 40cm x 40cm x 40cm; and
- Other items as determined by AusCycling management that may cause injury or public nuisance.
