



Volunteer Role Descriptions

Track Centre Liaison	This role includes but is not limited to, assisting teams (riders), Media and commissaires with any requests. It will include liaising with event staff and ensuring the track centre runs effortlessly through the racing. Finally, you will be responsible for ensuring the track centre is kept in a clean and tidy state throughout racing, this includes, clearing rubbish, wiping up spills on the floor etc. This role does not need any previous experience; however, it will be physically demanding as you will be on your feet for long periods at a time.
Rider Entry	This role involves ensuring only people with appropriate accreditations enter the track centre for both prior to race days and while racing is underway. As the track centre is a busy area, it is important only people with required access enter. This role needs no prior experience.
Media Entry	This role involves ensuring only people with appropriate accreditations enter the Media centre while racing is underway. As the track centre is a busy area, it is important that people with required access enter. This role needs no prior experience.
Steward	This role is to ensure the spectators have a positive experience throughout the racing. The role involves, helping people getting to their seat, helping people find the toilet and any requests spectators may have. The role does not need any prior experience however it will involve standing for long periods of time.
Spectator Entrance	This role involves checking spectator tickets as they enter the event. If people have not pre purchased tickets, you will be required to assist them how/where to purchase them online. If the session is sold out, you may have to turn customers away. This job does not need any prior experience.
Medal Presentation Organisation	This role involves helping with the organisation of the medals and other necessary parts of the medal presentations throughout the weekend. and available on Thursday 1 st February and all three evening sessions would be highly desirable.
Medal Presenter	This role involves presenting the medals and gifts to the athletes at each medal presentation. The role is looking for young adults 14+. This role does not need any previous experience; however, the role is required everyday

	throughout the event. Volunteers must be available Thursday 1 st Evening, and all three evening sessions of racing. Times are as the volunteer signup sheet.
Start Gate	This role is to ensure the start gate is taking on and off the track foe timed events on day one. The role needs previous experience using the gate at a state or national level at a minimum. If you do sign up for this role, pleased ensure you comment your previous experience.
Result Report	This role will involve taking results from the track centre to various parts of the track. It includes helping the commissaire with any timing or judging information they need to be transported to another person. This job does not need any prior experience, however it will involve a lot of walking and standing for long periods of time.
Camera Operator	This role involves using the judge commissaire camera to follow the racing as it happens. It involves working with the commissaire to capture the racing to help them make decisions throughout the weekend. Preferably some previous use of a video camera is desirable however not necessary. Volunteers would be needed to do a minimum of 1x session per day throughout the racing. Note: this is not livestreaming, it is for internal racing use only.
Accreditation Support	The accreditation office is open from Monday 29 th January to Sunday 3 rd February 2023. This role will involve, handing out accreditations to appropriate people, assisting with volunteer rosters and general event admin processes. This role does not need previous experience.
VIP Event assistant	This role is to help at the VIP event on Saturday 3 rd February Evening. It includes, ensuring only VIP guests attend the event and any other jobs the event manager may need. This role does not need any prior experience.
